Challenge

Many public and private premises in the southeast U.S., like parks, universities and golf courses, have problems with alligators. Safety messages – whether in the form of warning signs on premises or safety labels on products – should warn against reasonably foreseeable risks. Most of today's environmental safety signage consists of text-only word message signs not formatted to the latest best practice standards.

Solution

To improve on the current situation, Clarion developed a safety sign format that uses the latest warnings technology: the ANSI and ISO best practice standards. The new signs include a recently-registered ISO safety symbol to warn about the presence of alligators.
