This technology better communicates safety as it: provides critical information needed by viewers to make safe decisions (such as the nature of the hazard, the consequence of interaction with the hazard, and how to avoid the hazard); is supported by human factors research on effective warnings and by modern risk assessment methodologies; accommodates multiple language panels and graphical symbol panels to communicate safety to non-English readers; and meets current legal criteria for "adequate warnings" as defined by the past thirty years of U.S. case law.
