



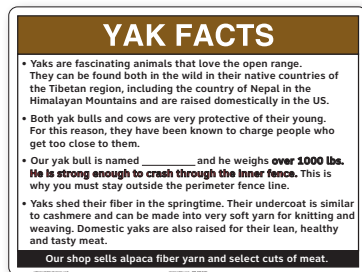

## Yak Safety Signage

### Case Study: Protecting People in Farm Environments

A yak ranch and agritourism destination in northern lower Michigan had a unique safety challenge. The farm's yaks presented a very real danger to visitors if people approached too close to an inner fence where the animals were being raised. Clarion developed a best practice sign system to help warn about the potential hazard of yak attacks, something that can happen, especially when the yaks have newborn calves to protect. Our signs use state-of-the-art symbols, eye-catching color-coding and the latest ANSI Z535 and ISO design principles to communicate to viewers the nature of the hazard and how to avoid it. The signs are designed to be repeatedly posted along the fence, in order to make sure people who stop their cars and want to look at the yaks are able to see the warning over the entire course of the field's fence line. A second outer perimeter fence line is now installed, along with "YAK FACTS" signs that provide additional reading material for the sightseers, who are now at a safe distance away from the inner fence. Reducing risk, protecting people; that's what Clarion is all about.
